Job description:

General Manager (Power Project) will report to the General Manager (Power). The job shall include but not be limited to the following:

- 1. Responsible for all activities of the power plant including operations, maintenance, health, safety, environment, and statutory requirements
- 2. Overseeing the operations of the power plant ensuring the power plant is operated and maintained in accordance with OEM manuals
- 3. Monitoring power generation ensuring high level of output, availability, and efficiency
- 4. Assessment of current operations and provide recommendations for continuous improvement across the plant
- 5. Liaising with stakeholders and ensure execution of Power Export is in line with PPA with GUVNL
- 6. Ensuring timely procurement of all power plant spare parts required for smooth operation and overhauls
- 7. Ensuring minimum cost of power production and minimum fuel consumption as part of cost saving initiative
- 8. Coordination and implementation of management plans for the plant performance and cost saving projects
- 9. Overseeing the planning and execution of all power plant maintenance activities including Preventive maintenance, Predictive maintenance, Breakdown maintenance, Annual Overhauling, etc.
- 10. Responsible for planning, revising, implementing, and monitoring policies and risk management procedures and other policies
- 11. Overall responsibility for the HSE management and compliance with all statutory requirements
- 12. Coordination with government agencies and regulators
- 13. Other duties as may be assigned by the GMDC top management
